



Over the next few weeks work will start on the A421 continuing to dual the carriageway up to Junction 13 of the M1 from Magna Park.

As the majority of this site falls under Central Bedfordshire Council's area the project is being led by them and their contractor, Morgan Sindall will be carrying out the works.

The completion date for this project is the end of 2020.

The initial preparatory work will run from August 2018 to February 2019, clearing the site, putting in new boundary fencing, and relocating utility pipes and cables.

The major dualling work of the road will start in February 2019.

There will be diversion routes in place where required and details of these will be on the website below and publicised in advance to road users.

There are weight limits zones in surrounding villages, which will be enforced by the police, so large goods vehicles like HGVs should still keep to the main road routes unless they are making local deliveries.

A 40mph speed restriction will be in place during part of the project to make the work site safe for staff working there.
