### **Rubbish**

Following our site inspections it has been recorded that rubbish is being stored on and behind plots along the hedge line, this breaks the terms of your Tenancy Agreement. Tenants are reminded that all walkways must be left clear and unobstructed at all times. The ridings/paths behind plots along the border are not part of your plot and must be kept clear so that the Council can maintain the hedges. Placing a shed or storing wood and other items outside the boundary of your plot is a health and safety risk and is not permitted. All tenants are also reminded that it is your responsibility to remove rubbish from the site and dispose of it in a suitable place, please do not leave rubbish on empty plots or by the entrance gates, it is not the responsibility of the Council to dispose of rubbish for allotment tenants.

Please remember if anyone is caught breaking any of the rules of the tenancy agreement they will be evicted from the allotments.
