



Dumped or badly stored rubbish creates a fire risk



Rubbish is a target for arsonists, as well as an eyesore. If you store it next to a building, that could go up in flames too, putting lives at risk



- DO** store your rubbish in a secure area if possible
- DO** keep garage, shed and outbuildings locked
- DO** keep all flammable liquids locked away
- DO** contact Milton Keynes Council to report fly-tipping, or to have large items removed*

- DON'T** put bins or sacks out for emptying until the day your refuse and recycling is collected
- DON'T** allow rubbish to block escape routes
- DON'T** store rubbish by doors, windows or other openings
- DON'T** store bins or sacks up against your home
