Dear Neighbour,

As part of our continuing works ahead of the construction of the Bletchley High Level Station and Bletchley Flyover, we need to relocate the compound and weighbridge near the Brunel roundabout. We also need to carry out some road improvement works near the roundabout.

Please be aware, that we will be working the following hours on weeknights and Sundays:

- Monday 16<sup>th</sup> November to Friday 20<sup>th</sup> November 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM
- Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> November 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM
- Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> December 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM

In addition, we will be carrying out temporary sheet piling activities near the West Coast Main Line.

The activity is part of the rebuild phase of the Bletchley Flyover. The sheet piling will be installed around several of the remaining flyover piers near to Buckingham Road. The piled sheets will provide ground support for the pier foundations in order to carry out re-strengthening works to the existing piers which will support the new Bletchley Flyover.

Due to their proximity to the operational railway, these works are only permitted to be undertaken during rail possessions when the West Coast Main line is closed.

As such, please be aware that this activity will take place on the following nights:

- Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> November 11:00 PM to Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> November 11:00 AM
- Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> December 11:00 PM to Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> December 11:00 AM
- Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> December 11:00 PM to Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> December 11:00 AM
- Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> December 11:00 PM to Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> December 11:00 AM

Our working hours are dictated by the times we are granted possession of the railway, and this can vary from week-to-week.

We appreciate that these works are disruptive to the local area, and we are doing what we can to minimise the noise by using noise reducing equipment.

We would like to apologise in advance for any disturbance these essential works may cause.



We have asked those working on site to work with consideration for the local community.

These works are continually reviewed with Milton Keynes Council.
