

# FURTHER NOTICE

## THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (ALL ROADS WITHIN MILTON KEYNES – HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2020

**FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** in relation to a temporary prohibition of vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along parts of roads within Milton Keynes whilst essential inspections, maintenance and repair works are carried out to the carriageway. The restrictions were brought into effect under the provisions of the above-named Order, which was made by the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes on 10th March 2020 under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as first notified on 5th March 2020.

**TAKE NOTICE** that works are for defects Maintenance works, it is necessary to introduce a road closure in order for the works to be carried out.

The following lengths of road will be closed on the following dates:

### 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020

- Forfar Drive, Bletchley (Between 9:30am – 12:30pm)

*Whilst the above road closure is in place the alternative route will be via Forfar Drive, Whaddon Way, Middlesex Drive and Surrey Road (and vice versa)*

### 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2020

- Regent Street, Bletchley (Between 9:30am – 12:30pm)

*Whilst the above road closure is in place the alternative route for eastbound traffic will be via Albert Street, Queensway and Oxford Street, and for westbound traffic via St Martin's Street, Cambridge Street, Cawkwell Way, Princes Way and Albert Street (and vice versa)*

- Overgate, Campbell Park (Between 12:30pm – 4:30pm)

*Whilst the above road closure is in place the alternative route will be via Avebury Boulevard, Enmore Gate and Childs Way (and vice versa)*

The above roads are scheduled to be closed and **only** when maintenance or repair works are required and **only** when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

Access to affected properties will be granted where possible. All other provisions of the Order remain as previously notified on 5th March 2020.
