

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (V4 WATLING STREET (PART), BLETCHLEY) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2020**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes intends, in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles and pedestrians from entering, waiting or proceeding along **Watling Street (V4), Bletchley** (for approximately 230 meters in a North Westerly direction) from its junction with Kelly's Kitchen Roundabout to carry out the installation of a new gas main for the construction of a new Housing development.

The closure will come into effect at the following days and times:

- 8.00pm on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October until 6.00am on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> October 2020;
- 8.00pm on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> October until 6.00am on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> October 2020;
- 8.00pm on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> October until 6.00am on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> October 2020;
- 8.00pm on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> October until 6.00am on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2020;
- 8.00pm on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October until 6.00am on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October 2020.

The road will be re-opened as normal outside the times shown above.

Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route (diversion route) will be via A5, Bletcham Way, Saxon Street and Watling Street (Vice-Versa).

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the closure.

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2020 and remain in effect for a period of 3 months and will take effect at times during the above period only when works are required and only when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual. All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
