

PUBLIC NOTICE

MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (DENBIGH ROAD (PART), BLETCHLEY) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Milton Keynes City Council has on 23rd May 2023 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along the following parts of road to allow Fibre Network Solutions to lay duct and chambers:

Denbigh Road, Bletchley – from the junction with Second Avenue for approximately 45 meters in a Southeasterly direction.

The above closure will come into effect on 5th June 2023 and is scheduled to be reopened on 7th June 2023 (24 Hours).

Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route (diversion route) will be via Denbigh Road, Bletcham Way, Saxon Street and Watling Street (and vice versa).

The Council is satisfied that a temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on 5th June 2023 and remain in effect for a period of 3 months and will take effect at times during the above period only when works are required and only when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
